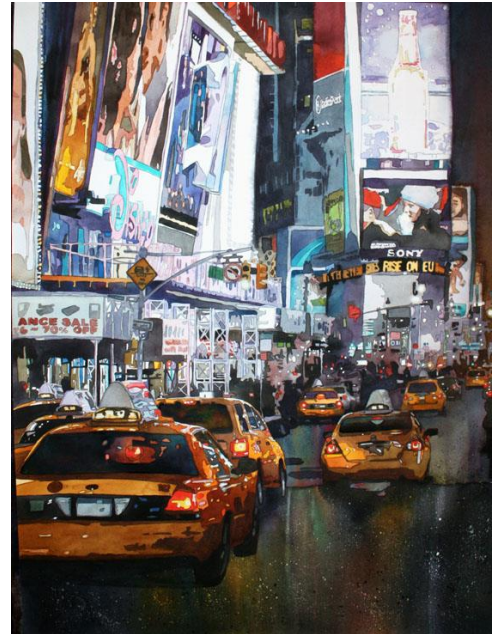


2017 WVWS Workshop

The 2017 WVWS workshop will feature award-winning artist and fellow WVWS member **Laurie Goldstein-Warren**, who lives near Audra State Park near Buckhannon, WV. The workshop is scheduled for July 13 through July 16 and will again be at the Timberline Four Seasons Resort near Davis, WV.

The Timberline Four Seasons Resort can be reached at 1-800-SNOWING, or online at www.timberlineresort.com. It is located two miles from the Canaan Valley Ski Resort which is near Davis, WV. The main highway to reach Davis is WV Rt. 32. For those coming from the west and south, Route 32 can be accessed from the community of Harman, located east of Elkins, WV. For those coming from the west and north, you can reach Rt. 32 at Thomas, WV. For those coming from the east, use Corridor H (U.S. 48), which will intersect with Rt. 32 at Davis.

Laurie Goldstein-Warren is a nationally known workshop instructor and artist. She has achieved national awards and recognition in numerous exhibitions including the High Winds Medal, AWS; Gold Medal Fellowship, NWWS; Best of Show, TWSN; and Silk Road Exhibition in China. Laurie will present her workshop of painting reflections on glass and wet city streets. You can use your favorite city and paint a scene with the many lights and bustling activities. With both the cityscape and the glass design you will learn to break down the scene to a workable composition and then paint it with various techniques and tools to make it sparkle! We will use transparent watercolors and acrylics in an aqueous manner. Make the glass and night shine using the skills you will learn in this workshop!

You can stay wherever you find accommodations in the Canaan Valley area, but the Timberline Resort, which can be reached at 1-800-766-9464, has rooms available for us at \$75.00 plus tax per night. They will offer breakfast and lunch on site and the rooms are very comfortable with a microwave and refrigerator. Snacks will also be provided each day. There are also several restaurants in the area if you want to explore the local cuisine and mountains.
